Day 1: Porto

Boarding from 5.00pm and time to settle comfortably in your cabins before being presented to the crew during a welcome cocktail reception

Dinner on board followed by an optional trip by coach to see the Porto by night

Day 2: Porto

Today you will set off to explore Porto on an optional guided tour. One of the oldest cities in Europe, whose historic centre is classed as a world heritage site by UNESCO: unspoilt old quarters, a maze of winding narrow streets, arcaded houses, superb churches. But above all, Porto is Port wine: among the wine properties that extend as far as the eye can see along the Douro in Vila Nova de Gaia, we will visit a famous cellar where this exceptional wine slowly ages in the greatest secrecy. Tasting of the "precious nectar"

Back on board for lunch, followed by a free afternoon to discover Porto at your own pace Return on board for dinner and a fado evening

Day 3: Porto-- Regua

In the morning, optional excursion to visit Porto, one of the oldest cities in Europe Return to the ship for lunch and then cruise onto Regua, admiring the marvelous scenery that the cruise offers You will pass the locks of Crestuma and Carrapelato, which is the highest in Europe Dinner followed by a crew show

Day 4: Regua - Vega De Teron

Optional excursion to Vila Real, famous for the variety of its religious architecture

Join the ship again in Pinhao at Lunch time

Afternoon spent cruising through the heart of the famous Porto vineyards, passing the locks or Valeria and Pocinho, arriving in Vega de Teron in the evening

Dinner and a Spanish evening on board

Day 5: Barca D'alva

Optional excursion to Salamanca awarded World heritage status by Unesco for the outstanding beauty of its Roman, Arabic and Christian architectural treasures

Lunch in Salamanca then return to the ship in Barca d'Alva at the end of the afternoon





Day 6: Barca D'alva - Ferradosa - Pinhao

Early morning cruise to Ferradosa, followed by an optional excursion to a Porto wine tasting Back on board at Folgosa for lunch. Cruise towards Leverinho and admire the wild landscapes and impressive rocky outcrops along the way

Dinner on board followed by a folk evening

Day 7: Pinhao - Porto

Departure from Pinhao by coach for the optional guided tour of Lamego. You will discover the Nossa Senhora dos Remedios sanctuary and the cathedral

Get back on board for lunch then, an afternoon's sailing, passing through a number of large locks Arrival in Porto at the end of the evening

Dinner and traditional evening on board

In the morning, disembarkation and transfer to the international airport for your departure flight

Booking terms & conditions

Regarding CroisiEurope - Croisimer Products:

Your registration will be taken into account as soon as you have paid the down payment amounting to 30% of the price of the trip on registration.

The trip cannot be guaranteed unless full payment of the sum has been received within 30 days of the day of departure.

Non-payment of the balance within the given dates shall be considered as a breach and subject to an immediate contract cancellation clause.

As for registrations made within 30 days preceding departure, the total value must be paid at the time of registration.





Cancellation Charges:

In the event of cancellation by the customer, the refunding of sums already paid shall be made after deducting cancellation charges per person, as listed below, depending on the cancellation date in relation to the departure date, and non-refundable expenses such as insurance, booking and visa fees as well as any other cancellation charges required by the suppliers. Cancellation charges for CroisiEurope river cruises:

- More than 60 days prior to departure: 50 Euros excl. of tax per person
- From 60 to 51 days: 40 % of the total value of the package
- From 50 to 30 days: 50 % of the total value of the package
- From 29 to 20 days: 60 % of the total value of the package
- From 19 to 3 days: 75 % of the total value of the package
- 48 h prior to departure: 100 % of the total value of the package

Cancelling CroisiEurope Cruises:

The Company reserves the right to cancel any cruises in a case of force majeure, adverse climatic or recurrent natural events (rise or fall in water level, cyclone...) or any event likely to result in certain services not being ensured for reasons related to the safety of passengers. Said cancellations can be decided at any time prior to departure with no obligation other than that of refunding sums received. In this case, customers cannot claim any additional damages. Whenever possible CroisiEurope will give passengers the possibility of choosing an alternative cruise of equivalent value and passenger will be entitled to choose between the alternative cruise or a refund, within the terms provided for in such conditions. Should the passenger choose the alternative cruise, he will not be entitled to a refund or compensation. CroisiEurope reserves the right to cancel any cruise up to 21 days prior to departure in the event of insufficient participants; in this case the customer will not be entitled to any form of compensation. The minimum number of participants is set at 80 people for CroisiEurope & CroisiMer cruises, and 130 people for Volga river cruises and 30 people for Dniepr river cruises. Concerning the other destinations in CroisiVoyages stays and tours, the minimum number of participants is indicated in each price table.

Modification in Cabin Categories Or Numbers By The Ship-owner:

For technical or operational reasons, river boating companies or ship-owners can allocate a cabin other than the one appointed or chosen by the passenger at the time of booking. Whenever this occurs, the new cabin must at least belong to the same category. Said change cannot be seen as a valid reason for cancellation by the customer or as a significant modification in the contract and shall not therefore give rise to compensation.
