Day 1 Saturday: Arrival – Madrid

Upon arrival at Madrid airport, meet greet and transfer to the hotel
Rest of the day at leisure

Day 2 Sunday: Madrid

Morning at leisure to continue exploring the wonders that the city has to offer

Day 3 Monday: Madrid – Cordoba – Sevilla

Early in the morning, drive southward along the land of Don Quixote
Cross through the natural border of “Despeñaperros” and get into Andalucía, a region for itself that shows and enormous heritage from a splendorous past
Upon reaching Cordoba, visit its Mosque and other sites that will ease your mind and spirit strolling through its narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter
In the afternoon, after a short two hours ride reach Sevilla

Day 4 Tuesday: Sevilla

In the morning, monumental and Panoramic city tour – the Cathedral (from outside), the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peters in Rome, the Santa Cruz Quarter, a natural scenario of “Carmen” as well as a precisely where the myth of “Don Juan” developed, the Maria Luisa Park and Spain square
Afternoon at leisure for you to discover exclusive views, specific flavors of this active full of light city
Dinner and accommodation at the hotel

Day 5 Wednesday: Sevilla – Granada

Drive east through the Caliphate road to the heart of Andalucía observing an endless number of olive trees on the way to Granada and its incredible and amazing monumental environment, last stronghold of the Moorish Kingdoms up to 1492
Visit the world famous Alhambra (Red Palace) and Generalife Gardens, fountains, gardens, patios that have inspired several authors with its sound and sights, such as the “Tales of the Alhambra” by W. Irving
Dinner and accommodation at the hotel

Day 6 Thursday: Granada – Valencia

Morning drive looking for the Mediterranean coast via Murcia, capital of the fertile garden of the Segura river, continue north via Alicante, the second largest city within the autonomous region land of Valencia
Reach Valencia one of the main capitals of the Mediterranean coast with its modern Arts and Sciences Architectural Complex integrated by six elements: Hemispheric, Umbracle, Science Museum, Oceanographic, Palau de les Arts and Àgora
Valencia is also the home of the internationally well renowned and delicious “Paella”

Day 7 Friday: Valencia – Barcelona

Morning city tour of this bright city including a drive through the old city showing the most prominent buildings, then be drive past the old riverbed of the Turia to the most avant-garde complex “Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias” to watch the emblematic exteriors of the six buildings
Early afternoon departure northward all along the Mediterranean coast to Catalunya, via Tarragona, the Roman Tarraco. Reach Barcelona principal Mediterranean city homeland of the famous architect Gaudí symbol of the Catalanian modernism



Day 8 Saturday: Barcelona

Morning city tour of Barcelona driving along the main avenues with impressive modernist buildings by Gaudí such as La Pedrera, Casa Milá, declared World Heritage buildings
The Montjuich Park with spectacular views of the city and harbor, Olympic Ring, monument to Columbus and the emblematic Gothic Quarter, heart of the old city and its historical centre
Afternoon at leisure
