Day 1 Tuesday: Arrival – Madrid

Upon arrival to Madrid international airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel

Day 2 Wednesday: Madrid

Optional night tour to attend a show of Fado, typical Portuguese song and music

Day 3 Thursday: Lisbon

Morning sightseeing tour of the ancient Olissipo, drive through its main squares and avenues, Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, Coach Museum, Monument to the Discoverers, Marquis of Pombal Square and Liberty Avenue. Afternoon at leisure for you to catch the nostalgic corners of Alfama Quarter, the old city gathered next to its Castle, with old buildings nested in narrow twisting "Ruas"

full of colour housing the genuine "tabernas" where Fado sounds as a missing past

Day 4 Friday: Lisbon-Obidos-Alcobaça-Nazare - Batalha - Fatima

Drive northland, arrive to the first point of interest: the beautiful walled town of Óbidos with its picturesque streets and the Pousada do Castelo. Continue to Alcobaça visit a 12th century church

containing the tombs of Pablo and Inês de Castro

Lunch at Nazaré, the most colorful of Portuguese fishing villages

Weather permitting, continue to the Sitio to have a panoramic view of the beach and the village Afternoon visit the Batalha Monastery, a masterpiece of Gothic and Manueline style considered a

World Heritage place by UNESCO

Continue to Fátima

Day 5 Saturday: Fatima – Lisbon

Day at your leisure for activities of personal nature in Fátima, center of Christian faith and World Pilgrims Sanctuary with its impressive Basilica and Cova da Iria where Virgin Mary appeared

At the end of the day returns to Lisbon through the colorful farming region

Day 6 Sunday: Lisbon – Caceres – Cordoba

Departure at 07:30 hrs to Caceres considered as World Heritage place because of the city's blend of Roman, Islamic, Northern Gothic and Italian Renaissance architecture. Walk through its Plaza Mayor

and the Old Town with its famous Medieval Quarter

Afterwards, continue on towards Cordoba, once the capital of the Caliphate

Day 7 Monday: Cordoba – Sevilla

Impressive tour of Cordoba's Mosque and other sites that will ease our mind and spirit strolling

through its narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter In the afternoon, after a short two hours ride reach Sevilla

Day 8 Tuesday: Sevilla

Morning Monumental and Panoramic city tour – the Cathedral (from outside), the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peters in Rome. The Santa Cruz Quarter, a natural scenario of "Carmen" as well as a precisely where the myth of "Don Juan" developed. - The Maria Luisa Park and Spain

Day 9 Wednesday: Sevilla – Ronda – Costa del Sol

In the morning, drive south passing typical villages. Reach Ronda; time free to admire this town of

international tourist areas

Day 10 Thursday: Costa del Sol – Granada

Departure towards the city of Granada and its incredible and amazing monumental environment, last stronghold of the Moorish Kingdoms up to 1492. Visit the world famous Alhambra (RedPalace) and GeneralifeGardens, fountains, gardens, patios that have inspired several authors with its sound and

sights, such as the "Tales of the Alhambra" by W. Irving

Day 11 Friday: Granada – Toledo – Madrid

Drive northward where it emerges, toward the sky of Castilla and surrounded by the Tagus River, the impressive Imperial city of Toledo –World Heritage City- where the three cultures Christians, Moorish and Jewish, have lived together. Resume of the Spanish art, history and spirituality the whole town is a National Monument. The City tour includes the most important monuments, its narrow streets and

the famous "Damasquinado" (gold and silver inlaying in iron)
