Day 1: Arrival in Yerevan

Upon arrival in Yerevan, meet greet and transfer to the selected hotel

Day 2: Yerevan

Enjoy a Yerevan city tour including City center, Republic square, State University, City panorama, Mother Armenia Monument, Parliament, President's Palace, Opera, Sports & Concert Complex

Later on, visit to the Genocide Memorial, dedicated to the Victims of 1915 and the Genocide Museum, Proceed to Matenadaran (depository for ancient manuscripts, which collection is one of the biggest in the world) This outstanding collection includes manuscripts dating from 7th century and is widely appreciated by history and art amateurs and professionals

Continue to Cascade complex, which is considered the modern art center of Yerevan, with art pieces displayed throughout the whole area and finish your tour at the ruins of Erebuni fortress

Day 3: Yerevan - Etchmiadzin - Zvartnots - Yerevan

Morning drive to Etchmiadzin, the spiritual and administrative center of Armenian Apostolic Church Visit to Etchmiadzin Cathedral (4th c.), the museum, St. Hripsime's Church (7th c.) and the ruins of Zvartnots temple (7th c.)

Day 4: Yerevan - Khor Virap - Noravank - Areni Winery - Yerevan

In the morning, visit to Khor Virap Church. Here is also the closest and most spectacular view of the gorgeous biblical mountain Ararat shining with its two white peaks

After visiting Khor Virap drive through the spectacular canyon between the red rocks toward Noravank Monastery (13th c.). Tour to "Areni" Winery and enjoy wine tasting

Day 5: Yerevan - Lake Sevan - Dilijan (Haghartsin) - Yerevan

Today, you will drive to Sevan, one of the greatest high mountainous freshwater lakes of Eurasia, and visit Sevan Monastery (9th c.). Drive to mountainous resort Dilijan, walk on craftsmen street, visit to Haghartsin Monastery complex (13th c.), including Church St. Stepanos, St. Mary and St. Gregory's Church, as well as famous refectory. Appearing unexpectedly, out of the thick forests, in front of the visitors, the Monastery creates a magical impression of the lost world and then visit to Goshavank Monastery (13th c.)

Day 6: Yerevan - Garni - Geghard - Yerevan

In the morning, drive to the only remaining pagan temple in Armenia devoted to the God of Sun – Myrth, in Garni Photo stop at Charentc Arc. Visit to the ruins of Royal Palace and Royal bath-house nearby. Drive to the unique caved temple St. Geghard (12th -13th cc.). Geghard Monastery is included in the UNESCO World Heritage list (2000) The program includes family hosted lunch in village house and watching of "Lavash" (Armenian traditional flat bread baked in stone-make oven) making process

Day 7: Yerevan

Visit to one of the city's museums Rest of the day at leisure

Day 8: Yerevan

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight
