

Day 1 Saturday: Arrival - Madrid

Day 4 Tuesday: Sevilla

Day 5 Wednesday: Sevilla - Granada

Day 6 Thursday: Granada – Valencia

Morning drive looking for the Mediterranean coast via Murcia, capital of the fertile garden of the Segura river, continue north via Alicante, the second largest city within the autonomous region land of Valencia Reach Valencia one of the main capitals of the Mediterranean coast with its modern Arts and Sciences Architectural Complex integrated by six elements: Hemispheric, Umbracle, Science Museum, Oceanographic, Palau de les Arts and Ágora

Valencia is also the home of the internationally well renowned and delicious "Paella"

Day 7 Friday: Valencia – Barcelona

Morning city tour of this bright city including a drive through the old city showing the most prominent buildings, then be drive past the old riverbed of the Turia to the most avant-garde complex "Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias" to watch the emblematic exteriors of the six buildings

Early afternoon departure northward all along the Mediterranean coast to Catalunya, via Tarragona, the Roman Tarraco. Reach Barcelona principal Mediterranean city homeland of the famous architect Gaudí symbol of the Catalonian modernism
