


# Philipsburg, St. Maarten to Lisbon, Portugal



# Day 1: Embark the m/v Tere Moana in Philipsburg, St. Maarten

The smallest island in the world to have been partitioned between two nations (France and the Netherlands), St. Martin/St. Maarten has prospered in peaceful coexistence for nearly 350 years. Embark the m/v *Tere Moana* on the Dutch side of the island, St. Maarten, and enjoy time at leisure in its historic capital, renowned for its pastel-colored buildings, flower-filled courtyards, wealth of dining venues, and lively nightlife. The ship sets sail late in the evening.

# Days 2-9:At Sea

A transatlantic crossing is one of the great traditions of cruising. The advent of the steamship during the 19th century made seafaring far safer than the sailing vessels of old and helped pave the way for the Golden Age of travel at the turn of the century. It was during this era that the idea of travel for pleasure was popularized, and crossing the sea aboard a luxury ship became a destination in itself. Now you can relive this romantic era aboard a deluxe vessel that recalls the luxury of those distant days.

The m/v *Tere Moana* was designed with your comfort in mind, offering spacious staterooms, elegant dining areas, and a host of amenities to while away the days at sea. # Day 10: Santa Cruz de La Palma, Canary Islands, Spain

*The Moana* moors today at Isla de la Palma, north westernmost of the seven Canary Islands. A paradise off the northwest coast of Africa, this archipelago boasts a unique culture that blends Spanish, African, Latin American, and European influences. In Santa Cruz de La Palma, located against a mountainous backdrop on the island's east coast, admire elegant colonial architecture, stroll a cobbled promenade lined with shops and cafés, or visit a replica of Columbus' famous ship, the *Santa Maria*.





# Day 11: At Sea / Madeira, Portugal

Relax to the rhythms of the sea today as *The Moana* heads toward Madeira, the Portuguese archipelago northwest of the Canary Islands. Perhaps you'll work out at the ship's Fitness Center. Or simply curl up in a deck chair with a book from our onboard reading gallery.

Early this evening, *The Moana* arrives at Madeira, the archipelago's largest island. As the ship enters the stunning azure harbor of Funchal, the capital of Madeira, you'll see why the approach to the city is considered one of the two most beautiful in the world (the other being Rio de Janeiro, Brazil). In this clean, crescent-shaped city, flowers bloom year-round, exquisite scenery greets the eye at every turn, and balmy breezes blow. You'll have this evening and all day tomorrow to explore this "Floating Garden of the Atlantic."

# Day 12: Madeira

You'll have a full day today to experience the charms of Madeira. Enjoy the plentiful walking trails, watersports, and dazzling shops, restaurants, and nightlife of this sophisticated urban center borne of a pirate stronghold. Or take advantage of a choice of shore excursions that reveal the island's exquisite interior.

## Days 13: At Sea

Enjoy two more days at leisure to experience the amenities of *The Moana*. Perhaps enjoy a live performance by our onboard pianist, or watch a movie on the private DVD player in your stateroom. And linger with new friends over an elegant meal in one of the ship's two dining venues.

# Day 14: Lisbon, Portugal

Lisbon was the departure point for Portuguese explorers during the 15th century's "Age of Discovery," and monuments to this golden era may be seen in the city's historic center, which was built on seven hills and can be reached only by funicular or elevator. These include the Tower of Belém and Jeronimos Monastery, which together are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Another highlight of the city is Monsanto Park, one of the largest urban parks in the world.

# Day 15: Disembark in Lisbon, Portugal

One of the oldest cities in the world, Lisbon is the capital of Portugal and its largest city. It is also the westernmost capital in Europe—and one of the most beautiful capitals on the continent. Disembark *The Moana* here this morning, cherishing the memories of your classic voyage.

# **Booking terms & conditions**

#### **Cancellations and refunds:**

The following cancellation charges will apply to any cancellation by guests:

## Date of cancellation charge:

121 days or more prior to Departure Date: Administrative Fee of \$100 per person

120-91 Days Prior to Departure Date: 10% of Full Fare per person

90 – 61 Days Prior to Departure Date: 20% of Full Fare per person

60 – 31 Days Prior to Departure Date: 50% of Full Fare per person

30-0 Days Prior to Departure Date: 100% of Full Fare per person

For this purpose, "Departure Date" means the date the sea, air/sea or air/sea/land program first departs and "Full Fare" means the full cost of any cruise, hotel or air component purchased from PGS or PGPS. Some components may have different refund and/or cancellation policies and penalties and, if so, these will explained at time of booking.

#### Children:

Any child under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21. If the adult accompanying the child is not a parent, a "Parental Consent Guardianship Form" must be signed by a parent or legal guardian and received by PGC prior to sailing. The ships are not able to accommodate children under one year of age and reserve the right to restrict the number of those under three years of age on board. Babysitting services cannot be arranged in advance, and the availability of such services is not guaranteed. Parents must be diligent to guard their children while on or near the balconies or any railing. The ships are not equipped to provide pre-natal, post-natal or pediatric services.





## Deposit and payment:

A deposit of 20% of the fare is required within 72 hours of booking to confirm a reservation. Payments cannot be transferred to an alternative booking within 120 days of sailing. Unless otherwise noted, final payment must be received by PGC 90 days prior to date of travel. Final payment must be received within 48 hours of booking for bookings made 89 to 30 days prior to sailing. For reservations made 29 days or less prior to sailing; full and final payment will be due at the time of booking. PGC reserves the right to cancel any booking not fully paid at final payment due date. Payment may be made by bank wire, personal check, American Express, Visa or MasterCard. Once a deposit is made, all changes are subject to an administrative/cancellation fee.

PGPS arrangements will require payment at time of reservation/booking. Payments cannot be transferred to an alternative booking within 120 days of travel. Once payment is made, all changes are subject to an administrative/cancellation fee.

# Dress code for evenings:

Evenings on board are elegant, yet they are not formal. "Country Club Casual," or resort wear, is appropriate for all evenings. For gentlemen, slacks and a button-down or traditional polo shirt, for example. No ties are required at any time, although gentlemen may wish to bring one blazer to wear on the evening of the Captain's Welcome Reception. For ladies, slacks, skirts or informal dresses are recommended. Please note that jeans, shorts, T-shirts and for gentlemen open shoes (such as flip flops, crocs or sandals) are not appropriate for evening wear on board
