Day 1: Strasbourg

Boarding in Strasbourg between 6.00 and 7.00pm. Time to settle comfortably in your cabins before meeting the crew during a welcome cocktail reception. Dinner on board before setting off on a guided river boat tour (optional) of the old city (depending on availabilities)

Day 2: Strasbourg - Rudesheim

Breakfast on board while cruising up the Rhine towards the charming town of Rüdesheim, passing great towns like Speyer with its famous cathedral, the massive port facilities in Ludwigshafen, and on via Mannheim and Worms (old Episcopal city), Mainz (capital of Rhineland-Palatinate). Lunch on board before arriving in Rüdesheim at 4.00pm. Disembark and enjoy some free time to discover the town for yourselves, or take an excursion (optional) to visit the musical instrument museum and have a ride on the miniature train. Dinner on board followed by a free evening in the lively Drosselgasse (with its open-air taverns and dance halls)

Day 3: Rudesheim - Koln - Dusseldorf

Sail off along the most beautiful stretch of the romantic Rhine where the lush vineyards are dotted with romantic castles, and on past the legendary Lorelei rock. Lunch on board before continuing on towards Koln, passing Koblenz and Bonn. Take advantage of a 2 hour stop to visit the town with your escort. Return to the ship and cruise on in the direction of Düsseldorf. Dinner and gala evening on board. Overnight stop.

Day 4: Dusseldorf - Amsterdam

Cross the border in Emmerich the sails on from Utrecht to reach Amsterdam in the evening. Dinner will be served on board before enjoying some free time in the city, or spending the evening on a canal cruise (optional) to see the city sights. Overnight stop

Day 5: Amsterdam

After breakfast, spend the morning touring Amsterdam (optional) and its diamond merchants. The Dutch capital is indeed a truly delightful city with a rich and fascinating past, offering its visitors a striking contrast between traditional Ducth architecture and other more unusual landmarks such as the Red Light district. Return to the ship for lunch. The afternoon is devoted to an excursion to Keukenhof gardens (optional – open from mid-March to mid-May). Back for dinner on board before enjoying a free evening or ask to be dropped off in the center of Amsterdam (optional) for a walk around the Red Light district. Overnight stop.

Day 6: Amsterdam

Breakfast on board. Free morning in Amsterdam. Lunch before disembarking around 1.00pm. End of our journey.

Booking terms & conditions

Regarding CroisiEurope — Croisimer Products:

Your registration will be taken into account as soon as you have paid the down payment amounting to 30 % of the price of the trip on registration.

The trip cannot be guaranteed unless full payment of the sum has been received within 30 days of the day of departure. Non-payment of the balance within the given dates shall be considered as a breach and subject to an immediate contract cancellation clause.

As for registrations made within 30 days preceding departure, the total value must be paid at the time of registration.

Cancellation Charges:

In the event of cancellation by the customer, the refunding of sums already paid shall be made after deducting cancellation charges per person, as listed below, depending on the cancellation date in relation to the departure date, and non-refundable expenses such as insurance, booking and visa fees as well as any other cancellation charges required by the suppliers. Cancellation charges for CroisiEurope river cruises:

- More than 60 days prior to departure: 50 Euros excl. of tax per person
- From 60 to 51 days: 40 % of the total value of the package
- From 50 to 30 days: 50 % of the total value of the package
- From 29 to 20 days: 60 % of the total value of the package
- From 19 to 3 days: 75 % of the total value of the package
- 48 h prior to departure: 100 % of the total value of the package





Cancelling CroisiEurope Cruises:

The Company reserves the right to cancel any cruises in a case of force majeure, adverse climatic or recurrent natural events (rise or fall in water level, cyclone...) or any event likely to result in certain services not being ensured for reasons related to the safety of passengers. Said cancellations can be decided at any time prior to departure with no obligation other than that of refunding sums received. In this case, customers cannot claim any additional damages. Whenever possible CroisiEurope will give passengers the possibility of choosing an alternative cruise of equivalent value and passenger will be entitled to choose between the alternative cruise or a refund, within the terms provided for in such conditions. Should the passenger choose the alternative cruise, he will not be entitled to a refund or compensation. CroisiEurope reserves the right to cancel any cruise up to 21 days prior to departure in the event of insufficient participants; in this case the customer will not be entitled to any form of compensation. The minimum number of participants is set at 80 people for CroisiEurope & CroisiMer cruises, and 130 people for Volga river cruises and 30 people for Dniepr river cruises. Concerning the other destinations in CroisiVoyages stays and tours, the minimum number of participants is indicated in each price table.

Modification in Cabin Categories or Numbers by the Ship-owner:

For technical or operational reasons, river boating companies or ship-owners can allocate a cabin other than the one appointed or chosen by the passenger at the time of booking. Whenever this occurs, the new cabin must at least belong to the same category. Said change cannot be seen as a valid reason for cancellation by the customer or as a significant modification in the contract and shall not therefore give rise to compensation.
