#### Day 1: Welcome to Beijing

Upon arrival to Beijing airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel

In the afternoon, enjoy a half tour of Beijing visiting many of the colorful facets of this large metropolitan city such as: Temple of Heaven and history-laden Tiananmen Square, two of the city s most famous sight, the new "Bird s Nest" Olympic stadium, and several of Beijing s futuristic sky scrapers

# Day 2: The Great Wall and Peking Duck

Today you will visit the Great Wall, the eighth wonder of the world. The giant wall extends for more than 6000 km through the countryside. On the way you visit the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Ming Tombs and the Spirit Way

In the evening, enjoy a dinner on the well-known delicacy of Peking Duck

## Day 3: The Forbidden City and Departure for Mongolia

In the morning, enjoy the awe-inspiring halls of the Forbidden City and mysterious temples In the evening your rail journey begins, as you transfer to the train station and depart for Mongolia aboard a chartered Chinese train

## Day 4: Crossing the Gobi Desert

Around noon reach the Chinese-Mongolian border, where you will be transferred to the Tsar's Gold private train. The change of trains is necessary because of the different track gauges in the two countries.

In the growing city of Erlian, you have some time to explore the colorful local market, before the Russian train sets off towards Mongolia

After crossing sections of the legendary Gobi Desert, the train travels through the vast green steppes of Mongolia

#### Day 5: Ulan Bator: A Lama Temple and the Buddhist Realms of Hell

In the morning arrival in Ulan Bator, the capital of Mongolia and enjoy a city tour visiting: The impressive Gandan Buddhist Monastery and the odd Choijin Lama Temple
In the evening have a unique change to attend a performance of traditional Mongolian folk arts including: throat singing, horse-headed fiddle playing, national costumes and dances

## Day 6: The Gandan Monastery and Mongolian Alps

Today you visit the Gandan Monastery, where it is possible to observe a Buddhist religious ceremony. Then, ride a bus that will take you to the Mongolian Alps with their majestic scenery and bizarre rock formations After a picnic lunch in a yurt camp, you will watch a small Mongolian horse-riding demonstration and a traditional wrestling match

# Day 7: Ulan Ude

On this day you travel through the valley of Mongolia s largest river, the Selenga Enjoy the scenery while on the way to Ulan Ude to reach the main route of the Trans-Siberian Railway Here profit from an informative city tour

## Day 8: Lake Baikal

In the morning the train travels directly alongside Lake Baikal, on the old route of the Trans-Siberian Railway During two extended photo-stops, have a chance to explore and record the scenic beauty of the lake Enjoy a short boat excursion from Port Baikal onto the lake. Take a swim in the lake, if you wish, and visit a picturesque Baikal village





#### Day 9: Irkutsk

In the morning arrive in Irkutsk, the capital of Eastern Siberia in tsarist times Enjoy a city tour and visit: the Okhlopkov Drama Theatre, the new memorial to Tsar Alexander III, and the photogenic market hall

Around noon pay a worthwhile visit to an open-air museum with a focus on life and work in historical Siberia

#### Day 10: Trans-Siberia

Today your train will pass through the diverse landscapes of eastern Siberia as you enjoy the sceneries

## Day 11: Novosibirsk

Around noon, your train arrives in Novosibirsk, the largest city in Siberia Enjoy a tour of this most Soviet of cities along your entire route, including the chance to see the mighty Ob River

# Day 12: Yekaterinburg

In the afternoon arrival in Yekaterinburg, the capital of the Ural Federal District Enjoy a city tour and see the Cathedral of the Savior on the Spilled Blood and the city centre

#### Day 13: Kazan

Reach Kazan early in the morning and enjoy a city tour visiting Tartar mosques and the most famous Russian Orthodox cathedral

Later on take a tour of Kazan s Kremlin and learn about the turbulent history of the relationship between the Tartars, the Cossacks, and the Russians

## Day 14: Welcome to Moscow

Around noon arrival in the Russian capital of Moscow, and visit the Kremlin grounds with its magnificent cathedral At night, discover the city s magic during an hour-long "City of Lights" tour, including a stop at Red Square, and a ride on the underground to view two of Moscow s particularly beautiful metro stations

## Day 15: Tour of Moscow and Flight Home

Today you will enjoy a city tour visiting the reconstructed Cathedral of Christ the Savior, Lomonossov University, the New Maidens Convent (Novodevichy Monastery), and Red Square with its colorful St. Basil s Cathedral, as well as to the notorious former KGB headquarters and the White House

Transfer to the airport for your flight back home
