Day 1: Lyon

Passengers are welcome to board the ship in Lyon at 6:00 p.m. After comfortably settling into your cabins, enjoy a welcome cocktail with the crew before dinner. Onboard entertainment will continue in the lounge. We'll remain in port overnight.

Day 2: Lyon - Macon

Optional excursions proposed:

CLASSIC: Join us for a guided tour of Lyon. You will discover the second largest city in France, situated at the confluence of the Rhône and the Saône.

DISCOVERY: Discover all of Lyon's touristic highlights in only 2.5 hours and with little effort! Enjoy a leisurely bike ride around the lake in the Parc de la Tête d'Or and on the banks of the Rhône River. Don't miss the tasting of local products and delicacies in the heart of Vieux Lyon!

We'll return on board and spend the afternoon cruising. Enjoy dinner and an evening of dancing and onboard entertainment. We'll reach Mâcon in the evening and remain in port overnight.

Day 3: Macon - Vienne

Optional excursions proposed:

CLASSIC: Set off by coach for our excursion to visit the abbey ruins in Cluny.

DISCOVERY: Your guide will lead you through the streets of Macon on foot to discover the rich heritage of this fascinating city. During your tour, you'll be able to taste many of the local products. You'll have some free time to explore on your own before heading back to the ship.

We'll return on board and spend the afternoon cruising. Enjoy an evening of onboard entertainment. We'll remain in port overnight.

Day 4: Vienne - Arles

Optional excursions proposed:

CLASSIC: Visit of Vienne. Once the capital of a Roman province, Roman vestiges are still visible in modern Vienne. DISCOVERY: Explore Vienne on a Segway! After familiarizing yourself with your Segway, you'll set off on an original tour of this charming "Gallo-Roman" city known for its art and history.

We'll return on board and spend the afternoon cruising. Enjoy dinner and an evening of entertainment as we cruise through the night.





Day 5: Arles - The Camargue

Optional excursion for both packages: Visit of Arles. You discover this cultural center and its Roman ruins, and then travel inland to find out about olive oil production in Provence.

Optional afternoon excursions proposed:

CLASSIC: Join us for an excursion to the Camargue—an immense exceptional plain where the sea, wetlands and pools are inhabited by an extraordinary variety of water fowl.

DISCOVERY: Safari in the Camargue. Far from the tourist traps, discover the Petite and Grande Camargue from the back of a jeep with local guides who will share their enthusiasm for this legendary area. You'll cross the Parc Naturel Régional de Camargue.

We'll return on board for dinner and an evening of traditional Provençal entertainment. We'll remain in port overnight.

Day 6: Arles - Avignon - Viviers

Optional excursions proposed:

CLASSIC: Guided tour of Avignon and the Papal Palace, one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe.

DISCOVERY: You'll leave by coach for the Pont du Gard, a true masterpiece of ancient architecture. We'll hike along the aqueduct trail, a 2-mile walk through the site with numerous viewing points. At the end of our trek, we'll visit the museum.

We'll return on board and spend the afternoon cruising. After dinner, we set off on an optional visit of Viviers. We'll remain in port overnight.

Day 7: Viviers - Tournon - Lyon

The morning will be spent cruising. Once we arrive in Tournon, join us for an optional excursion for both packages: A guided tour of the city. We'll visit the imposing Castle-Museum of Tournon-sur-Rhône, one of the finest castles in the Ardèche region. We'll then return on board. Tonight is our gala evening. Our boat will cruise towards Lyon during the night.

Day 8: Lyon

Regarding CroisiEurope - Croisimer Products:

Your registration will be taken into account as soon as you have paid the down payment amounting to 30 % of the price of the trip on registration.

The trip cannot be guaranteed unless full payment of the sum has been received within 30 days of the day of departure. Non-payment of the balance within the given dates shall be considered as a breach and subject to an immediate contract cancellation clause.

As for registrations made within 30 days preceding departure, the total value must be paid at the time of registration.

Cancellation Charges:

In the event of cancellation by the customer, the refunding of sums already paid shall be made after deducting cancellation charges per person, as listed below, depending on the cancellation date in relation to the departure date, and non-refundable expenses such as insurance, booking and visa fees as well as any other cancellation charges required by the suppliers. Cancellation charges for CroisiEurope river cruises:

- More than 60 days prior to departure: 50 Euros excl. of tax per person
- From 60 to 51 days: 40 % of the total value of the package
- From 50 to 30 days: 50 % of the total value of the package
- From 29 to 20 days: 60 % of the total value of the package
- From 19 to 3 days: 75 % of the total value of the package
- 48 h prior to departure: 100 % of the total value of the package

Cancelling CroisiEurope Cruises:

The Company reserves the right to cancel any cruises in a case of force majeure, adverse climatic or recurrent natural events (rise or fall in water level, cyclone...) or any event likely to result in certain services not being ensured for reasons related to the safety of passengers. Said cancellations can be decided at any time prior to departure with no obligation other than that of refunding sums received. In this case, customers cannot claim any additional damages. Whenever possible CroisiEurope will give passengers the possibility of choosing an alternative cruise of equivalent value and passenger will be entitled to choose between the alternative cruise or a refund, within the terms provided for in such conditions. Should the passenger choose the alternative cruise, he will not be entitled to a refund or compensation. CroisiEurope reserves the right to cancel any cruise up to 21 days prior to departure in the event of insufficient participants; in this case the customer will not be entitled to any form of compensation. The minimum number of participants is set at 80 people for CroisiEurope & CroisiMer cruises, and 130 people for Volga river cruises and 30 people for Dniepr river cruises. Concerning the other destinations in CroisiVoyages stays and tours, the minimum number of participants is indicated in each price table.





Modification in Cabin Categories or Numbers by the Ship-owner:

For technical or operational reasons, river boating companies or ship-owners can allocate a cabin other than the one appointed or chosen by the passenger at the time of booking. Whenever this occurs, the new cabin must at least belong to the same category. Said change cannot be seen as a valid reason for cancellation by the customer or as a significant modification in the contract and shall not therefore give rise to compensation.
