Day 01: Colombo - Dambulla

Upon arriving in Sri Lanka meet, greet and assist and transfer to Dambulla 4 Rest of the day at leisure

Day 2: Dambulla - Sigiriya Rock Fortress - Optional Minneriya National Park - Dambulla Cave Temple

Your first stop of the day will be at Sigiriya Rock Fortress, home to the 5th Century "Fortress in the Sky" which is perhaps the most fantastic single wonder of the Island

Then, proceed to Minneriya National Park. Located between Habarana and Polonnaruwa, the 8890 hectares of Minneriya National Park is an ideal eco-tourism location in Srilanka. The park consists of mixed evergreen forest and scrub areas and is home to Srilanka's favorites such as sambar deer, leopards and elephants Later on, visit Dambulla Cave Temple.

The cave temple consists of a complex of Buddhist image houses. Its rock ceiling is one large sweep of colorful frescoes, some of which dates back to over 2,000 years, which depicts Buddhist mythology, and the tales of the Buddha's previous births. This cave temple has the largest number of Buddha statues all housed in one place, including a 14 meter long, colossal figure of the recumbent Buddha carved out of the rock.

Day 03: Dambulla - Matale Spice Garden - Kandy

In the morning, proceed to Kandy

En route, visit a spice garden in Matale to see different spices for which Srilanka is famous for In the afternoon, enjoy a half day city tour of Kandy visiting:

Upper Lake Drive, Market Square, Arts & Crafts Centre, Gem Museum & Temple of Tooth Relic. Kandy the hill capital, venue of the annual Perahera The last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings was finally ceded to the British in 1815. Kandy is an example of the Buddhism's influence in Sri Lanka today. Temple's shrines and monasteries keeping alive Buddhist traditions are everywhere.

Day 04: Kandy - Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage - Temple of Tooth Relic - Cultural Show - Kandy

Your first stop of the day will be at Pinnawala Elephant orphanage, a conservation and educational center Also visit the Temple of the Tooth Relicin Kandy

By the night experience a colorful show where you will be taken to mind blowing Sri Lankan culture extravaganza... Get ready for Heavy drumbeat and acrobatic act

Day 05: Kandy - Peradeniya Botanical Garden - Kithulgala White Water Rafting - Waskaduwa

Today, proceed to Peradeniya and visit the Peradeniya Botanical Gardens Thereafter, proceed to Kithulgala, one of the most famous places for White Water Rafting adventures Get your shorts on and enjoy the water!

Day 06: Waskaduwa - Madhu River Boat Ride - Kosgoda Turtle Hatchery

Today enjoy a River Boat Ride in the 915 hectare Maadu Ganga Estuary Then proceed to the Marine Turtle Conservation in Kosgoda.

Day 07: Waskaduwa - Colombo

Upon arrival in Colombo, proceed with a shopping tour:

Visit ODEL, House of Fashion, Arcade Independence square, Race Course, and Beverly Street, visit bargain market in Colombo Pettah

Later on, visit a 100-year-old clock tower and several British built colonial buildings

Other places of interest are the Pettah bazaar - where one can shop for bargain, a Hindu and a Buddhist temple, residential areas where you find the stately homes of the affluent, the Colombo museum, the Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall (BMICH)- an outright gift to Sri Lanka from the People's Republic of China, the new Parliament and the Dutch Museum
