Upon arrival at Thessaloniki, meet greet and transfer to botel

#### *Day 2:* Thessaloniki

Enjoy a half day city tour of Thessaloniki for today. You will visit sights such as Galerius arch, Rotunta, The Roman Forum and Theater etc. You have the option to visit museums as well, such as Archeological museum, Museum of Byzantine Culture, The White tower, The Ataturk house

#### Meteora *Day 3:*

Your road trip will start early in the morning. First stop, Archaeological area of Dion: Hellenistic and Roman theatres, ancient paved streets, swimming pools and baths with mosaics, conservatory, Roman houses, mansions and basilicas, a beautiful exemplar of the ancient Greece

After Dion, Mount Olympus and Litohoro village. For thousands of years, Olympus is wrapped in the mist of the myth of its history. The multiform and volatile beauty of nature creates a magnificent landscape. Mountain peaks, canyons, streams, springs with crystal waters, vegetation and sounds embroider harmony and majesty of the mountain of Gods Continue your trip with a stop at Tempi, a heavenly place with its pure nature where sports like Rafting, Canoe and

Kayak will be available for you

Last stop, Meteora, where you will spend the night

#### Delfi *Day 4:*

Continue your trip to Delphi. The Oracle of Delphi was the most famous oracle of ancient Greece The night will be held at a picturesque, traditional village, Galaxidi Take a walk in the village and visit one of the traditional taverns for dinner

#### *Day 5:* Athens

Today you enjoy a half day city tour of Athens, with a visit to the Roman Temple of Olympian Zeus and the Acropolis Highlights include the impressive Parthenon, the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike and the Erechtheion, with its Porch of Maidens

After seeing the highlights of ancient Athens, the trip concentrated on modern highlights will follow A drive past the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in front of the Parliament House on Constitution Square Next stop, the Panathenian Stadium (site of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896) and the Presidential Palace (ex Royal Palace), government buildings and elegant houses. Along Panepistimiou Avenue you will be able to admire the Catholic cathedral, the Academy, University, National Library and Omonia Square.

### Day 6: Athens

This morning you can go an optional trip to Sounio. The dramatic coastal location of Sounio (Cape Sounion) in southern Attica was an ideal spot for a Temple of Poseidon, God of the Sea. Standing at top sheer cliffs overlooking the Aegean the marble temple has served as a landmark for sailors from ancient times to today. Sea.
