Day 1: Rome

Upon arrival to Rome meet greet and transfer to hotel

In the evening, enjoy a guided tour of the beautiful city

Discover the ancient city of Rome and its famous Colosseum

You will also discover Roman's vestiges like the Marcellus Theatre, the nephew of Auguste Emperor,

Circus Maximus, the biggest and most ancient racecourse of Rome or Hercule Vainqueur Temple Later on, enjoy a quick visit to Tibérine Island, unique island of Rome

Day 2: Rome

Today you will discover the biggest church of the world, Saint-Peter's basilica

You will admire one of the most beautiful and famous sculpture in the world, the sublime Pietà of Michel-Angelo

Continue with the visit of the Vatican Museum where you will see one of the main antique sculpture collections

Then, visit of Sixtine chapel, built in the XV century

Day 3: Rome - Sienna - San Gimigniano - Florence

Visit of Piazza del Campo, one of the most beautiful squares of the world

Discovery of Sienna cathedral, also called « Il Duomo ». Some masterpieces adorn the sanctuary like Michel-Angelo sculptures. Then, visit of Saint Dominique church which holds magnificent painting

Departure for San Gimigniano and upon arrival, enjoy a tour of Etruscan village of the XIII century perched into the hill overlooking the Elsa valley. The village is famous for its medieval towers. You will also discover Piazza della Cisterna or Piazza del Duomo

In the afternoon, transfer to Florence

Day 4: Florence - Venice

Today you will discover the city of Florence. The city was created by the Romans in the first century and was the cradle of the biggest art revolution: Renaissance

Discover Santa Maria del Fiore cathedral and its cupola created by Brunelleschi and finished in the XV century

The outside walls are in green, red and white marble. Visit also Campanile Giotto and Baptistery with the famous « Heaven's gate ». Continue your visit with the Piazza della Signora and the Palazzio Vecchio In the afternoon transfer to Venice

Day 5: Venice - Milano

In the morning, go to the artificial island of Tronchetto where you will have a boat trip on the Grand Canal Go through the Rialto Bridge to arrive at the St. Mark's Square. Guided tour of the historic centre of Venice through the St. Mark's Basilica, the Bell Tower, the Ducal Palace and the Bridge of Sighs By the end of the day transfer to Milan

Day 6: Milano - Rapallo - La Spezia

Today you will enjoy your discovery of Milan, Italy's financial centre and fashion capital
Visit the largest Gothic cathedral in Italy: the Duomo. Proceed through the shopping gallery of Vittorio
Emmanuelle to enjoy its shops and cafes

Continue with the visit of the Scala Theatre, the Sforzesco Castle By the end of the day transfer to La Spezia
