Day 1: Avignon

Upon arrival to Paris' international airport, board a train heading to Avignon Upon arrival to Avignon, private transfer from Avignon train station to the botel Welcome dinner in a fine restaurant

Day 2: Rhone Valley Wines

Early in the morning pick up from the hotel by a private vehicle and a friendly English speaking driver Departure for an educational trip with a wine expert about the wines of the Rhône Valley Visit and wine-tasting in a wine property in Tavel: famous for the rosé wine which complex nose of summer fruits evolves into smooth notes of pitted fruits and almonds

later on, visit the Roman theatre in Orange, one of the best preserved from the Roman civilization: it has kept its stage wall almost intact.

Driving tour in the vineyards in Château neuf-du-Pape and stop for panoramic view of the Rhône valley at the Castle of Château neuf du-Pape

Visit and wine-tasting in a Domaine in Château neuf du Pape: guided visit of the winemaking, the ageing and stocking cellars, followed by a tasting of a Chateau neuf-du-Pape white and red wine

Day 3: Provencal Cooking Class

Today, you will be picked up at the hotel by a private vehicle and a friendly English speaking driver Departure to the Alpille and visit of a local fruits and vegetables producer with an English speaking chef and discover the regional products, the forgotten ones and the seasonal ones which we will used for the receipee. Visit a goat cheese factory. Discovery of the herbs garden. Cooking class: you will learn how to prepare a lamb leg, how to cook crispy vegetables, how to prepare filet from an entire fish, and much more... Lunch (drinks included) either in a veranda opened on a garden or in the shade of the olive trees Taste olive oil in a mill in Les Baux de Provence valley, one of the most beautiful landscapes of olive groves in Provence, where olive-oil, cracked olives and black olives are entitled to the A.O.C. Label Continue to Les Baux de Provence, medieval village labeled as "one of the most beautiful villages in France". This immense and superb stone fortress is without doubt one of the "must-sees" on the Provencal tourist trail!

Day 4: Ventoux & Gigondas

Early in the morning you will be picked up at the hotel by a private vehicle and a friendly English speaking driver Visit and wine-tasting in a Castle in Mormoiron, a family-run vineyard in the south of the Rhône Valley on the Côtes du Ventoux appellation that operates on the principles of sustainable agriculture Picnic lunch in the wine estate

Continue to Gigondas for visit and wine-tasting in a cellar: Gigondas wines are considered as Cru of the Southern du Rhône valley. The village is located at the foot of the billrange called 'Dentelles de Montmirail'. *Côtes*

Day 5: Avignon – Paris

At a proper time, transfer back to Avignon train station and board a train back to Paris Upon arrival to Paris, meet greet and transfer to botel
