- Day 1:** **Zagreb**
Upon arrival at Zagreb airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel

Continue to Split, the second largest city of Croatia.

- Day 5:** **Trogir – Dubrovnik**
In the morning, leave Split towards Trogir
Your city tour will include the visit of the cathedral
Afterwards departure towards the south of the Croatian coast, passing by Makarska Riviera
Arrival in Dubrovnik
- Day 6:** **Dubrovnik**
Departure from the hotel towards the "old town" where you will meet your local guide and see the most important monuments of this city known as "the pearl of the Adriatic"
You will visit the rector palace and the Franciscan monastery with the most ancient pharmacy in the world
The afternoon is at leisure for you to continue exploring this beautiful city

Free time at leisure or you can participate in an optional excursion
- Day 8:** **Dubrovnik – departure**
Transfer to the airport for your departure flight
