# Day 3: Barcelona – Valencia (350 km - 5 bours)

## Day 4: Valencia – Granada (400 km - 5 bours)

Early in the morning, departure to Granada. At the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains, between the rivers Darro and Genil, lies one of the most interesting cities in Eastern Andalusia

## Day 5: Granada – Sevilla (260 km - 3 bours)

In the morning, visit to Albambra. There are places in the world that evoke a feeling of magic and adventure, and the Alhambra is one of those places. This Palace is the most visited tourist attraction in all of Spain, attracting millions of visitors per year

Continue the tour to Seville

#### Day 6: Sevilla – Córdoba (140km - 1:30 bours)

In the morning, visit the capital of Andalusia region. The Plaza de Espana, the centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero American Exposition followed by the famous building known as the Queen Sewingbox "El Costurero de la Reina", Triana neighborhood, the Golden Tower, the famous Calle Betis, the Bullring, Triana Bridge - the oldest in the city, designed by none other than Gustav Eiffel himself and the more modern bridges and the Pavilions, built du-ring the 1992

Close by also we'll see the famous Isla de la Cartuja and its Monastery where Christopher Columbus lived for some

After free time for lunch, then continue to Cordoba

See some of Cordobas most impressive monuments. Enjoy fabulous monuments like the Mosque, Cathedral, the fortified Alcázar and Gardens, the Jewish miqva and the Roman bridge crossing the Guadalquivir.

# Day 7: Córdoba – Toledo – Madrid (360 km - 4 bours)

The ancient capital of Spain - Toledo - is definitely worth a trip because there are rich of historical and impressive quarters, squares, monuments and buildings

# Day 8: Madrid

In the morning, enjoy the Capital of Spain! You will drive through Madrid's famous avenues, including the Gran Via and Castellana, to famous squares such as Plaza España, Puerta del Sol and Puerta de Alcalá. You will also visit Madrid's historic quarters and famous parks, including Casa de Campo and Retiro, Las Ventas bullring and the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium, which is the home of and of course Royal Palace and Prado Museum
