

Day 1: Delhi

Upon arrival to Delhi International Airport meet greet and transfer to hotel In the afternoon, proceed for a short sightseeing tour of Old Delhi: Visit the historic Red Fort - Shah Jehan's elegant citadel in red sandstone, the Jama Masjid Later on, take an interesting walking tour through the famous bazaars of Chandni Chowk Also visit Raj Ghat - the memorial to Mahatma Gandhi At night enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant

Day 2: Delhi – Agra

In the morning, proceed for a guided tour of New Delhi visiting:

Outb Minar, the 2nd tallest minar in India, Proceed to Bangla Sahib, the most prominent Sikh Gurdwara, or Sikh house of worship, in Delhi, known for its association with the eighth Sikh Guru, Guru HarKrishan.

Drive pass Parliament of India, President's house & India gate and finish your tour at the Lotus Temple. It is a Bahá'í House of Worship completed in 1986. Notable for its flowerlike shape, it serves as the Mother Temple of the Indian subcontinent and has become a prominent attraction in the city. After that, drive to Agra.

Dinner and overnight at hotel

Day 3:

The magical allure of the Taj Mahal draws tourists to Agra like moths to a wondrous flame. And despite the hype, it's every bit as good as you've heard. But the Taj is not a stand-alone attraction. The legacy of the Mughal empire has left a magnificent fort and a liberal sprinkling of fascinating tombs and mausoleums; and there's also fun to be had in the bustling (marketplaces).

In the morning, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Agra that will include the beautiful Taj Mahal considered as a world heritage monument and one of the wonders of

the world

Later on, visit Agra Fort considered as one the finest examples of the fusion architecture that has dominated the Mogul period Then visit a Marble factory to learn "Pietradura" an old technique of making marble products Dinner and overnight at hotel

Evening optional: Kalakrtiti Theatre Show

A stage show on Taj Mahal "Mohabbat the Taj" performed by the professional artist in an A/c auditorium.

Day 4: Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur

On this day you will drive to Jaipur with a stop at Fatehpur Sikri for a brief period of time Fatehpur Sikri was once the capital of the Mughal Empire. The city boasts of some of the magnificent monuments of the medieval period. Some of the attractions at Fatehpur Sikri are the Panch Mahal, the Buland Darwaza and the Dargah of Sheikh Salim Chisti Upon reaching Jaipur, transfer to the hotel and check in Rest of the day at leisure

Day 5: Jaipur

In the morning, you will explore Hawa Mahal. It is a pyramid-shaped facade with five stories, 953 small windows decorated with tiny lattice work. The small windows and screened balconies serve the women to watch processions and different activities taking place on the streets.

Then proceed to Amber Fort. Climb to the top of the fortress (climbing elephant is possible subject to availability, if not climb it with jeeps). Castle looks impressive, built entirely of white marble and red sandy rocks, with architecture influenced by Hindu and Muslim manner of ornamentation and decoration. Later on, drive by Jal Mahal. Near the cenotaphs of the maharanis of Jaipur, and beautifully situated in the watery expanse of Man Sagar, is the beautiful Jal Mahal. It was built in 1799 by Madho Singh as a summer resort for the royal family, which they used to base duck-hunting parties.

Finish the tour by visiting the City Palace. The beautiful palace was built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh during his reign.
