Day 2: Barcelona

This morning you will discover the capital of Catalonia. The most beautiful attractions covering the many highlights of the city. Enjoy spectacular city views and a glimpse of the 1992 Olympics complex during a stop in Montjuïc.

Then you will explore the Passeig de Garcia Avenue with a wealth of modernist architecture like Gaudi´s La Pedrera and Casa Batlló

Finish the tour in Eixample at the stunning Sagrada Familia

In the afternoon free time in Ramblas, Gothic Square and Plaza Catalunya

Day 3: Barcelona - Valencia (350 km - 5 hours)

Early in the morning, departure to Valencia, the city of Fallas and Paella.

Bathed by the Mediterranean Sea it possesses a rich heritage as the bullring, the Plaza de la Virgen, the Cathedral visiting the town hall square

Rest of the day at leisure

Day 4: Valencia – Granada (400 km - 5 hours)

Early in the morning, departure to Granada. At the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains, between the rivers Darro and Genil, lies one of the most interesting cities in Eastern Andalusia

Day 5: Granada - Sevilla (260 km - 3 hours)

In the morning, visit to Alhambra. There are places in the world that evoke a feeling of magic and adventure, and the Alhambra is one of those places. This Palace is the most visited tourist attraction in all of Spain, attracting millions of visitors per year Continue the tour to Seville

Day 6: Sevilla – Córdoba (140km - 1:30 hours)

In the morning, visit the capital of Andalusia region. The Plaza de Espana, the centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero American Exposition followed by the famous building known as the Queen Sewingbox "El Costurero de la Reina", Triana neighborhood, the Golden Tower, the famous Calle Betis, the Bullring, Triana Bridge - the oldest in the city, designed by none other than Gustav Eiffel himself and the more modern bridges and the Pavilions, built du- ring the 1992 Exposition.

Close by also we'll see the famous Isla de la Cartuja and its Monastery where Christopher Columbus lived for some years. After free time for lunch, then continue to Cordoba

See some of Cordobas most impressive monuments. Enjoy fabulous monuments like the Mosque, Cathedral, the fortified Alcázar and Gardens, the Jewish miqva and the Roman bridge crossing the Guadalquivir.

Day 7: Córdoba - Toledo - Madrid (360 km - 4 hours)


In the morning departure to Toledo
