TheN visit Christ the Savious Cathedral, the most majestic and grandiose cathedral of Moscow. It was edified for the first time between 1839 and 1883, in memory of the Russian's victory on the Napoleon I, in 1931 it was dynamited and reduced to rubble and then, in 2000 rebuilt again Lunch in Restaurant,

In the afternoon, visit of Tretyakov gallery and have a walk in Arbat Street, one of the oldest streets in Moscow.
