Scotland has long been renowned for its salmon fishing on some of the most famous salmon rivers in the world. The Atlantic salmon, Salmo salar, run most Scottish rivers of any size, making their way from the marine feeding grounds in the North Atlantic into Scotland's rivers and upstream to reach the spawning redds by late autumn, covering distances of hundreds, sometimes thousands of miles, often against the odds, through strong flows, rough rapids and barely surmountable waterfalls in the process, hence its Latin name Salar, the "leaper".

# Day 4: Fort William

Inverlochy Castle boasts its own loch within its grounds - Loch Na Marag
You enjoy a full day's fishing in your hotel's loch with your private ghillie
You may also like to travel out to the upper River Garry, where trout and salmon fishing is fantastic (may be subject to a supplement)

#### Day 5: Benderloch

Today you are privately transferred to the Isle of Eriska Hotel. During the transfer, take time to explore the shops of Fort William. You may wish to take the gondola up the slopes of the nearby mountain called Aonach Mor, from where excellent views of the region are possible Drive along the shores of Loch Linnhe, and turn into the eerie Glencoe valley

## Day 6: Benderloch

Spend time exploring the local area around Oban. You may go shopping in the town centre, and visit the nearby salmon smokehouse at Inverawe. Here you may wish to visit the three trout lochs and a salmon river within walking distance for a day's fishing
