DAY 1, TUE 24 DECEMBER:

DAY 3, THU 26 DECEMBER:

Witness aspects of Jewish life in Berlin, from the iconic golden dome of the reconstructed New Synagogue to architect Daniel Libeskind's impressive Jewish Museum, then relive the Golden Twenties - the Berlin of glamour, creativity and cabaret. The tour will end with lunch in a local restaurant. The afternoon is at leisure before the evening performance at the Staatsoper.

DAY 4, FRI 27 DECEMBER:

This morning transfer by coach to Berlin's Dahlem district and the Brücke-Museum which houses the world's largest collection of works by Die Brücke, an early 20th-century expressionist movement. Lunch and the rest of the day is free for you to further explore this fascinating city as you wish.

DAY 5, SAT 28 DECEMBER:

The day is at leisure for sightseeing or shopping at one of the city's many Christmas markets that will still be open. Walk to the Komische Oper that evening for this tour's final opera performance.

DAY 6, SUN 29 DECEMBER:

Transfer to the airport for the homeward flight.
