**Day 1: Toronto**

Upon arrival at Toronto's international airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel.

**Day 2: Toronto - Quebec City**

Early in the morning, we will depart from Toronto and proceed to Quebec City, where we will explore the European architecture, shops, and art galleries of the Old City. We will walk around, take pictures, or enjoy a cup of coffee at a sidewalk cafe to experience the city in style. After dinner, we will proceed to our hotel for the evening.

**Day 3: Quebec City - Riviere-du-Loup - Fredericton**

In the morning, we will make our way to Riviere-du-Loup, QC, where we will have the chance to go on a whale watch that will take us out onto the sea to see seals and belugas. Then, we will make our way to Fredericton, the capital of New Brunswick. On the way, we will pass the Hartland Covered Bridge..

**Day 4: Fredericton – Halifax**

Today we will journey into Nova Scotia, where we will visit the amazingly scenic Peggy's Cove. From there, we will go to Halifax, NS, where we will ride the Harbour Hopper, an amphibious vehicle that takes guests on a narrated land-and-sea tour of the city. We will spend the night in Halifax.

**Day 5: Halifax - Prince Edward Island - Charlottetown - Park Corner**

Today we will take the ferry to Prince Edward Island. Our first stop will be Charlottetown, PE, a historic city home to the Province House National Historic Site. From there we will make our way to Park Corner, PE to visit Anne of Green Gables House. Guests will have the chance to enjoy an Lobster Dinner at your hotel.

**DAY 6: Prince Edward Island - Moncton - Saint John - Fredericton**

Today we will leave Prince Edward Island and return to New Brunswick. We will visit the town of Moncton, NB, home to the picturesque Hopewell Rocks, the mind-blowing Magnetic Hill, and the World's Largest Lobster Statue. We will then proceed to Saint John, NB to see the beautiful scenery before heading back to Fredericton, NB for the night.

**Day 7: Fredericton - Montreal**

In the morning, we will go to Hartland, NB to visit the Hartland Covered Bridge and the Covered Bridge Chips Factory. Afternoon, we will arrive in Montreal, QC. Here we will visit Olympic Stadium and Tower, Notre-Dame Basilica and Old Montreal. We will spend the night in Montreal.

**Day 8: Montreal - Ottawa - Thousand Islands – Toronto**

Today, we will leave Montreal behind, bound for Ottawa, Canada's capital city, where we will spend time on Parliament Hill. From there, we will drive to the Thousand Islands region, where we will get the chance to take a boat tour of the area. In the evening, we will return to Toronto.

**Day 9: Toronto - Bruce Peninsula - Flowerpot Island - Toronto**

Today, we will journey to one of the most beautiful locations in Ontario, Bruce Peninsula. This majestic setting contains miles of shoreline, clear blue waters, amazing coves, sandy beaches, limestone cliffs, wooded trails, and much more. Once we are there, we will take a glass-bottom boat tour of Little Tub Harbour in Tobermory. Along the way, we will see the Big Tub Lighthouse and more. Afterwards, we will reach Flowerpot Island. If the boat tour is not operating due to weather conditions, we will take a walking tour of Bruce Peninsula National Park instead. Later on, we will return to Toronto.

**Day 10: Toronto - Niagara Falls - Toronto**

In the morning we will visit Niagara Falls, ON. There, we will take the Hornblower Cruise boat ride, see an IMAX Movie, and Skylon Tower. We will return to Toronto in the evening.

**Day 11: Toronto**

In the early morning, we will explore downtown Toronto, stopping to take photographs at the Legislative Assembly of Ontario, the University of Toronto, and Chinatown. We will then have the chance to climb to the top of the CN Tower, a signature of the city's skyline and a symbol of Canada. On the observation deck, we will enjoy a panoramic view of Lake Ontario and the city. If weather permits, we will then take a sightseeing cruise to Central Island across the Toronto Islands (In Winter time, we will visit Ripley's Aquarium of Canada instead of cruise). After lunch, we will visit another Toronto landmark, Casa Loma. Then, we will stop at the Yorkdale Shopping Mall for a brief shopping trip.

**Day 12: Toronto Departure**

The Outlet Collection in Niagara-on-the-Lake is Canada's largest open-air shopping center, covering over 520,000 square feet. This refreshing new outlet concept features more than 100 irresistible outlet brands including the Tommy Hilfiger Outlet, the J Crew Factory Store, the Nike Factory Store, Coach, Fossil, and much more, all with unbeatable outlet prices. At the south end of the property, guests will find a food court called the Eatery. We will return to Toronto, where the tour will come to an end. Drive to Toronto's international airport for your departure flight.
