### Day 1: Nairobi

Upon arrival at Nairobi's international airport, meet greet and transfer to the hotel

## Day 2: Kigali

Rwanda's buzzing capital, home to the Parliament Building, Geological Museum and moving genocide Memorial Centre, is your first stop — a local guide will introduce you to the sights and backstory. The elegant, central Kigali Serena Hotel is an ideal base.

### Day 3: Kigali / Butare / Nyungwe Forest

It's a long but fascinating drive west across the country from Kigali to Nyungwe Forest. There's plenty to see en route, from Nyanza Royal Palace, former home of the King of Rwanda, to the lively university town of Butare, where the National Museum showcases Rwandan life throughout the centuries. Relax after the journey at Nyungwe Forest Lodge, set in an expansive tea plantation overlooking the seemingly endless jungle.

### Day 4: Nyungwe Forest

Nyungwe is wildlife heaven: 13 different species of primate (including chimpanzees) and 275 bird species can be found among its old mahoganies, giant tree ferns and delicate orchids. Explore with an expert tracker, negotiating the verdant forest and steep slopes in search of colobus monkeys and more. Recover with a cuppa on a tour at the Gisakura Tea Plantation

#### Day 5: Nyungwe Forest / Gisenyi

Skirting the shores of glittering Lake Kivu, head north to Gisenyi, to reach the peaceful Lake Kivu Serena Hotel. The hotel is the perfect place to relax: it has its own private beach, refreshing pool and tennis courts, plus boats and fishing rods if you'd like to head out onto the water's of Africa's sixth largest lake

### Day 6: Gisenyi / Kinigi


The Virungas volcanoes rear up behind the Lake Kivu Serena, and an hour's drive will take you to Kinigi, in their rolling green foothills. Luxurious Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge gazes up to the mighty peaks, and is right by Volcanoes National Park — one of the last redoubts of the critically endangered mountain gorilla

## Day 7: Kinigi

Nothing quite compares to meeting a mountain gorilla. They're so powerful, yet so strangely human: it feels a little like gazing at your ancestors. Join an experienced guide this morning to plunge into the thick, wild forest in search of one of the national park's habituated gorilla families; once you've tracked them down, you'll be allowed an hour in their company, to watch them eat, preen and play.

#### Day 8: Kinigi / Kigali

Today there is the option to go and track the gorillas for a second time or track the golden moneys (at additional cost for the permits) or simply relax at the lodge taking in the magnificent views. Finally, wrench yourself away, to return to Kigali for a final night relaxing at the Kigali Serena Hotel.
