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Day 1: Casablanca

Upon arrival at Casablanca Airport, meet greet and transfer to your hotel Dinner and overnight .

Day 2: Casablanca- Meknes - Fez (320 km)

After breakfast, departure to Casablanca to visit Hassan II Mosque, Mohamed square, united nations square, Habbous, Royal palace, Ain Diab Cornich, residential area of Anfa and panoramic view, transfer to Meknes Known as Moroccan Versailles" Meknes was founded at the end of the 17th Century by Moulay Ismail, sightseeing tour of the city, Bab Mansour, Lahdim square.

Continue to the old Roman ruins of Volubilis.

Arrival at Fez in the evening.

Day 3: Fez

After Breakfast, full Day visit of the oldest Imperial city and the Cultural Capital of the kingdom, which was founded in 790 B.C by Moulay Idriss II. visit the Royal Palace, the karouine Mosque, Attarine Medersa, Nejjarine fountain, then continue the visit of Medina, and souks. Dinner and overnight.

Day 4: Fez-Ouazzane-Chefchaouen (210 km)

After Breakfast, departure to Chefchaouen Via Ouezzane. Many of Moroccan consider Ouezzane to be a holy city and make pilgrimages there to venerate the tomb of several marabouts (Moroccan saints). Continue to Chefchaouen: is a city in northwest Morocco. It is the chief town of the province of the same name, and is noted for its buildings in shades of blue. Dinner and overnight in Chefchaouen.

Day 5: Chefchaouen-Rabat-Marrakech (380 Kms)

After Breakfast, departure to Rabat: the political capital of the Kingdom since 1912. Visit Kasbah of Oudayas, Hassan Tower, Mohammed V Mausoleum and the Royal Palace. Then continue to Marrakech. Dinner and overnight

Day 6: Marrakech

Breakfast, the whole day will be devoted to the visit Marrakech and it's main monuments: Menara Gardens, Jardin Majorelle Koutoubia Minaret, Bahia Palace. Gueliz district and the markets around Djemaa El Fna main square in Marrakech's ancient Medina. Dinner and overnight

Day 7: Marrakech-Casablanca (280 Kms)

Breakfast, then departure to Casablanca. Free time at leisure. Dinner and overnight.

Day 8: Casablanca-Departure

Transfer to Casablanca airport and flight back home
