


Vibrant Rajasthan

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Day 01: Delhi

Upon arrival at Delhi's international airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel

Proceed for the guided city tour of Old & New Delhi:

In Old Delhi visit the historic Red Fort (photo stop from outside) - Shah Jehan's elegant citadel in red sandstone. Very near the Fort is the Jama Masjid (Friday Mosque), India's largest mosque, also built by Shah Jahan.

Go for an interesting walk through the famous bazaars of Chandni Chowk, which is adjacent to both the Fort and the Mosque. Also visit Raj Ghat - the memorial to Mahatma Gandhi.

Welcome Indian lunch at local restaurant

Afternoon guided sightseeing of New Delhi & drive past India Gate, the memorial of the First World War and the road that leads from there to President House, which is flanked by the houses of Parliament and the Government Secretariat buildings. Visit Lotus Temple - although the temple belongs to the Baha'i sect, is open to people of all faiths. Visit the Qutub Minar, a Tower of Victory that was built in the 12th century by Qutbuddin Aibak.

Evening Optional Visit of Akshardham Temple (On Extra Charges)

Day 02: Delhi-Agra by surface

In the morning, drive to Agra. On arrival check in at the hotel

Afternoon we will take you for sightseeing tour of Agra which includes the beautiful Taj Mahal.

First we will visit the majestic marble edifice, Taj Mahal. The Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan built the Taj Mahal in the memory of his beloved wife, Mumtaj Mahal. Taj Mahal, the epitome of love and romance stands on the banks of river Yamuna. The architecture is considered as the finest specimen of Mughal style of architecture.

Visit Agra Fort is among the finest examples of the fusion architecture that has dominated the Mogul period. The assimilation of these different styles has given the buildings within the fort a distinctive look.

Dinner at the hotel

Day 03: Agra-Fatehpur Sikri-Jaipur

Today you will head to Jaipur; while driving there you will stop at Fatehpur Sikri for a brief period.

Fatehpur Sikri was once the capital of the Mughal Empire. The city boasts of some of the magnificent monuments of the medieval period. The buildings at Fatehpur Sikri present a unique blend of Hindu and Islamic architectural styles.

Some of the attractions at Fatehpur Sikri are the Panch Mahal, the Buland Darwaza and the Dargah of Sheikh Salim Chisti.

Continue your drive to Jaipur. Upon arrival check-in at your hotel

Evening enjoy Rajasthani dinner at local restaurant

Day 04: Jaipur

This morning you will drive 11kms in the outskirts of the city to visit Amber Fort, the ancient capital of the State until 1728. Visit the Temple of Kali, the Hall of Victory or Jai Mahal and Jagmandir. You can have the unique experience of traveling on elephant back to and from the top of the hill on which the fort is situated.

Afternoon city tour of the pink city, visit the City Palace - the former royal residence built in a blend of the Rajasthani and Mughal styles which houses a museum with a superb collection of Rajasthani costumes and armoury of the Mughals and Rajputs, including swords of different shapes and sizes with ornate handles. It has an art gallery with an excellent collection of miniature paintings, carpets, royal paraphernalia and rare astronomical works in Arabic, Persian, Latin and Sanskrit.

Also visit the Jantar Mantar - an astrological and astronomical Observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh in 18th century, which is remarkable for its accuracy even at the present times.

Stop at Palace of Winds for taking pictures. Later back to the hotel & rest.





Day 05: Jaipur-Udaipur

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for flight to Udaipur Upon arrival, meet greet and transfer to hotel Rest of the day is at leisure for own activities Evening enjoy dinner at local restaurant

Day 06: Udaipur

Morning will start with a sightseeing tour of the city. You will be visiting Jagdish Temple, the largest temple in Udaipur. Visit Saheliyon Ki Bari, the garden of maidens. Pools with elegant kiosks, flowerbeds, lawns, pools, fountains, along with an array of trees make this garden eye-catching.

Later explore City Palace. A fusion of Medieval European and Chinese architecture, the City Palace was built by Maharaja Udai Singh. This marble monument is situated on the eastern banks of Lake Pichola. Numerous balconies, towers and cupolas of the palace provide a marvelous view of the lake and the city below. A triple arched gate called Tripolia, built in 1725, provides the entry to the palace.

Late afternoon you will enjoy a leisurely boat ride on Lake Pichola. With its main attractions being the two palaces on the islands in the lake, Jagniwas and Jagmandir; Lake Pichola is about 4 km in length and 3 km wide. Jagniwas was earlier the summer retreat of the prince of Mewar and now a five-star hotel.

Day 07: Udaipur-Delhi

Afternoon transfer to Udaipur airport to board flight for Delhi Upon arrival in Delhi, transfer to the hotel & check-in

Day 08: Delhi

In time transfer to Delhi airport to board flight back for onward destination
