Day 01: Colombo - Pinnawala - Kandy

Upon arrival at Colombo's international airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel in Kandy

En route visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage - a home for about 60 elephants (out of which around 50 are baby elephants) found abandoned or orphaned in the wild

Proceed to Kandy and in the evening enjoy a cultural show

Dinner & Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 02: Kandy (Excursion to Nuwara Eliya)

Today you will enjoy an excursion to Nuwara Eliya. En route visit a Tea factory & Tea Plantation where one the best tea in the world is produced. You will be told all about the process of manufacturing tea and also see how tea is graded. Taste a cup of pure Ceylon tea in the factory\

Upon arrival in Nuawara Eliya check-in to the hotel

Do a city and sightseeing tour in Nuwara Eliya, Sri Lanka's premier hill resort with a fine bracing mountain climate. It is also the heart of Sri Lanka's tea country producing 50% of the world's best tea.

Day 03: Kandy – Matale – Dambulla - Habarana

In the morning, proceed to Habarana. En route visit a spice garden to see the different spices that Sri Lanka is famous for. You will be introduced to different spices and shown how some of these spices are grown and processed.

Dambulla Rock Temple - was built by king Walagambahu in the 1st century B.C. Dambulla is a world heritage site and is the most impressive of Sri Lanka's cave temples. The complex of five caves with over 2000 sq. meters of painted walls and ceilings is the largest area of paintings found in the world. The caves contain over 150 images of the Buddha of which the largest is the colossal figure of the Buddha carved out of rock and spanning 14 meters. Dinner & Overnight stay at the hotel

Day 04: Habarana — Sigiriya - Minneriya - Habarana

In the morning, proceed to Sigiriya

Sigiriya is a unique witness to the civilization of Ceylon during the years of the reign of Kassapa I. The site of the 'Lion Mountain' was visited from the 6th century AD, by passionate admirers. The frescoes of Sigiriya inaugurated a pictorial style which endured over many centuries. Halfway up the rock, within an inaccessible rocky shelter in the vertical wall of the western face these rock paintings can be seen which have brought universal acclaim to the site of Sigiriya - 'The Maidens of the Clouds', 21 non-identified female figures, comparable to the most beautiful creations of Ajanta. Then, continue to Minneriya National Park in the North Central Province of Sri Lanka. The park is a dry season feeding ground for the elephant population dwelling in forests of Matale, Polonnaruwa, and Trincomalee districts.

Day 05: Habarana -Village Safari- Habarana

Today you will visit Hiriwadunnaa village. There you can experience rural Sri Lankan life. You can also get first hand experiences like cooking and ride in a cart.

Hiriwadunne village in Habarana offers a unique village safari for tourists. Any traveler wanting to gain an insight in to the daily lives of the locals in this village can participate on their own volition in excursions, adventure safaris, agro tourism, night camping and Jeep safaris.

Day 06: Habarana - Negombo

In the morning, proceed to Negombo

In the evening do a city tour in including Fish Market, Negombo Town, Catholic church & Old Dutch Canal. The wide sandy beaches and the safe sea are the major attractions of Negombo, a traditional fishing town. Besides the beach, the fish market is worth visiting where busy trading of a variety of fish including prawns, crabs and seer takes place in the mornings when the fishing crafts return to the shore with their catch. The most popular fishing craft is the outrigger canoe called oruwa dug out from a huge log andis seen in large numbers in the Negombo-lagoon. Dinner & Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 07: Negombo — Colombo
