# Day 4: Ile sur Sorgue, Fontaine-de-Vaucluse, Sénanque, Gordes

In the morning, depart to L'Isle sur Sorgue, a large Provencal market and then to Fontaine-de-Vaucluse, a small town at the foot of the plateau du Vaucluse, known because of its re-emerging source In the vicinity of Gordes visit the Cistercian Abbey of Sénanque, surrounded by lavender fields Continue to Gordes with its castle and its nice restored old houses overlooking the valley Stroll through the narrow streets of the village with its many craft shops

# Day 5: Forcalquier, Salagon

Today, travel in the direction of Banon and Forcalquier to admire en route the beautiful lavender fields Visit the monastery of Salagon. Here in the gardens one can learn a lot about the history and application of different Provencal plants

### Day 6: Marseilles

Transfer to Marseilles airport for departure flight
