Day 1: Arrival in Stockholm

Welcome to the fabulous capital of Sweden - Stockholm! Your private driver meets you at the airport and transfers you to your centrally located hotel for check-in.

The rest of the day is free to start exploring Stockholm attractions on your own, dine in a local restaurant or take a good rest in your comfortable room.

Day 2: Stockholm city tour

Following breakfast you meet your guide and enjoy a 3-hour walking city tour around the most interesting attractions of Stockholm.

During the tour you explore the brilliant Old Town of Stockholm that is one of the biggest and most well-preserved medieval Old Towns in Europe and see the famous Royal Palace, the Stockholm Cathedral and the City Hall.

After the tour you return to your hotel and have the rest of the day free to explore Stockholm on your own or enjoy one of our optional evening recommendations.

Recommended dinner: Dinner at a specialized Viking restaurant Aifur with authentic atmosphere and menu.

Day 3: Skansen and Vasa Museum

In the morning after breakfast your guide takes you to the Skansen Museum - the world's first open-air museum founded in 1891, that demonstrates the country's life before the industrial era. During the tour you take a fascinating journey through the five centuries of Swedish history, see the large collection of traditional rural houses and visit the museum's zoo that represents about 75 different species of both domestic and wild Scandinavian animals, including brown bears, seals, lynx and wolverines.

Later you walk to the nearby Vasa Museum rated as the most visited museum in entire Scandinavia. This museum is famous for being home to the only intact 17th-century ship in the world - the Vasa. Sank on its maiden voyage in 1628 and salvaged only 333 years later, it managed to preserve more than 95 percent of its body in original state.

After the tour you return to your hotel and have the rest of the day free.

Day 4: Trip to Sigtuna & Uppsala

After breakfast you meet your guide and driver and have a short ride to the authentic medieval towns of Uppsala and Sigtuna.

During your 6-hour sightseeing tour you explore all major cultural treasures of these beautiful cities and enjoy their unique atmosphere and amazing charm.

After the tour you are transferred back to your hotel in Stockholm.





Day 5: Ferry Trip to Birka (by Ferry)

This morning you have an exciting chance to learn about the Swedish history of Vikings during a group exploration of the ancient fields of Birka island.

Meals: breakfast.

Transport: return ferry from Stockholm. Sightseing: Birka Museum, ancient fields.

Stockholm-Visby: 5hrs 20 min (by ferry)

The Destination Gotland ferry is considered to have one of Europe's most modern services at sea. During the trip, you will be offered to enjoy delicious meals at Food Market or Bistro. Your driver takes you to the port and meets you upon the ferry's arrival

Day 6: Visby

Today you leave Stockholm and together with your local guide explore the most preserved medieval city situated in Gotland, (largest Swedish island).

Meals included: breakfast.

Transport: hotel - port, port - hotel transfers.

Sightseeing: Santa Maria Cathedral, Botanical Garden, the city wall.

Visby-Gothenburg: 2hrs 20 min (by plane)

Without a doubt, the fastest and most convenient travel option between Sweden's Visby and Gothenburg is on a plane. The airports have easy connections to the city centers, and you'll be taken to and picked up from the airports by your local drivers

Day 7: Visiting Gothenburg

Today you fly to a bustling port - Gothenburg and after hotel check-in, you set off on a sightseeing tour of the city, accompanied by a local guide.

Meals included: breakfast.

Transport: hotel-airport, airport-hotel transfers, flight.

Sightseeing: Haga district, Fish Market, Opera House, the Maritime Center.

Gothenburg-Malmo (by train)

Enjoy your time-saving connection between two beautiful Swedish cities. The modern train you take has great onboard amenities as well as boasts quick travel times. Drivers will take you to the station and pick you up upon arrival.

Day 8: Traveling to Malmo

It's time to move to another amazing Swedish city - Malmo. After 2.5-hour train journey, you arrive in the third biggest city in Sweden. Your driver takes you to the hotel for check-in, where you can settle in or begin exploring the area on your own. We recommend a visit to Lilla Torg market, full of cozy restaurants and cafes. By the way, if you wish to explore your Swedish heritage, we can organize specific activities for this evening.

Transport: station-hotel transfer, train.





Day 9: Touring Malmo

Shortly after having breakfast you go for a guided walk around the city. Your guide takes you to see the bridge that connects Sweden with Denmark, and the tallest skyscrapers in the whole Scandinavia and few incredible sights.

Meals included: breakfast.

Sightseeing: Old Town, Stortoget Square, Oresund Bridge, Turning Torso.

Day 10: Departure from Sweden

After breakfast and check-out, you catch a train back to Stockholm where you will be flying back from. We hope you had an amazing time in Sweden and are already dreaming about your next destination!

Meals included: breakfast.

Transport: Malmo-Stockholm train, hotel-airport transfers.
