Today you could explore one of the walking trails in the south, the Tet Paul Trail. You will pay a small fee and have a local guide from one of the villages that the trail passes over. The trail offers some excellent views, however you should try to avoid going at peak times to steer clear of the cruise ship crowds.





Day 11: Rodney Bay, St. Lucia

Today you will be transferred over to the area of Rodney Bay where you will spend the next few nights at your Villa Beach Resort, a relaxed, laid-back Caribbean retreat that equally offers lots of opportunities for being active and making the most of its beachside location.

Day 12: Rodney Bay, St. Lucia

Remember to take your snorkelling gear as you can head out from the shoreline here.

Head to Rodney Bay — you'll find plenty of bars and restaurants to choose from around the marina, which is also a great spot for people watching.

Day 15: Rodney Bay, International return flight

Today you will be transferred to the international airport for your flight home. Your return flight will arrive the second day.
